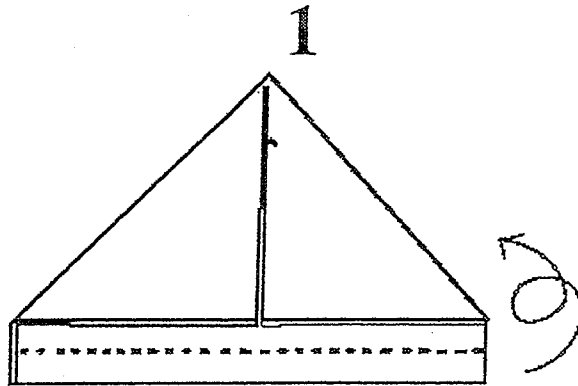


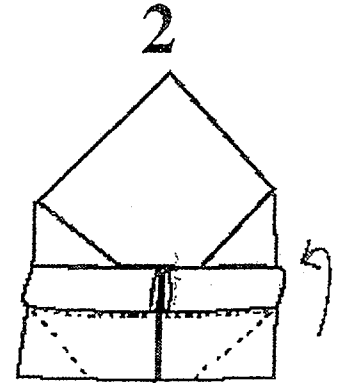
# TO MAKE A PRINTER'S CAP

Paper hats have been worn by printers, paper-makers, and typefounders for centuries, and are still worn by some. This is the way the hats were made in the 19th century.

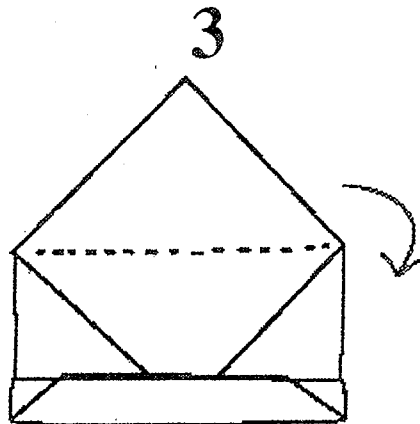


Take a double page of a newspaper.  
Turn it so that the fold is at the top  
and then turn the folded edge to the  
center to make two triangles and a flap.

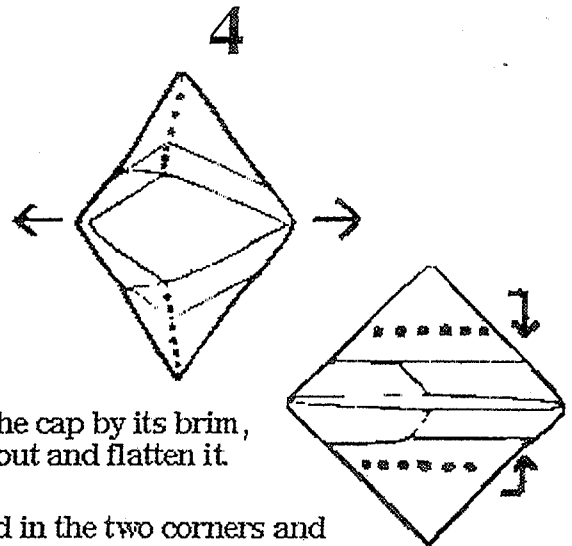
Taking the TOP SHEET ONLY  
of the flap, fold it in half and then  
fold it again over the triangle.



Turn the paper over.  
Fold each side to the center.  
Fold up the outside corners  
of the bottom flap,  
and then fold the flap itself up and  
tuck it into the brim above.

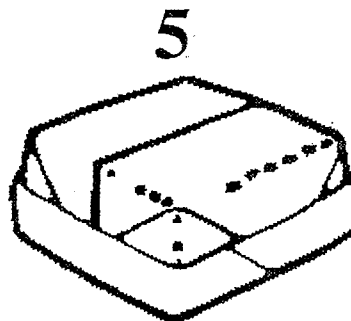


Fold the top down and  
tuck that into the brim too.



Pick up the cap by its brim,  
open it out and flatten it.

Fold in the two corners and  
tuck them under the brim.



Open out the cap and square it.
